COMPETITOR REGISTRATION

COMPETING AT HIGHLAND GAMES

Competing at Highland games is fun and rewarding. Firstly, you need to register with RSHGA as an athlete (see below), then decide which event(s) you want to compete at and contact the handicapper or secretary to check they have availability – contact details are listed on our website and yearbook.

Athlete Registration – Important Note

Registration is required prior to participating in athletic competitions at RSHGA member events (incl running, cycling, light field, heavyweight, tug o' war and hill races).

Only registered competitors are eligible to receive prizes, trophies, league points and personal injury cover. RSHGA is committed to clean sport: it is a condition of registration that athletes agree to comply with anti-doping rules and participate in testing if requested. **NO league points will be awarded until an athlete is registered.**

Please complete your registration on the website www.rshga.org and pay via Paypal. Alternatively email the RSHGA Treasurer [treasurer@rshga.org] for a form or print online and post to RSHGA Treasurer – Iain Watt, 9 West Fenton Court, Gullane, EH39 5AE [Cheques or POs payable to “Royal Scottish Highland Games Association” or “RSHGA”]. Please do not expect to register and pay on the day of competition, do so in advance.

Senior (ages 65 and over)	£10	PA* cover ends at 80yrs
Youth (under 16yrs)	£10	Includes PA* cover
Tug o' War	£40 per team	No PA* cover unless individually reg'd

Fees: One-Day Permit (only where competing at a single event in the year):

Registration Type	One-off Fee	Notes
Adult, incl Senior	£5	No PA* cover, no league points
Youth (under 16yrs)	Free	No PA* cover, no league points
Tug o' War	£10 per team	No PA* cover, no league points

* PA: Personal Accident- RSHGA organise a basic insurance cover free for athletes

Yearbook: Copies available from the Secretary at £6.00 each (incl UK p&p).

Insurance: While RSHGA arranges basic personal accident cover, athletes are encouraged to arrange their own public liability insurance to cover the risk of causing injury to others.

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION WITH THE RSHGA

I wish to register as a competitor with the RSHGA for season 2024. I have read, understood and agree to be bound by the rules of competition [including disciplinary procedures] and the UK Anti-Doping Rules. The UK Anti-Doping Rules are binding on all competitors participating at members events, for a minimum of 12 months from the commencement of membership, whether or not the competitor is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK. If the competitor wishes to retire from the sport, they will notify RSHGA in writing.

I agree that RSHGA may share my personal information with its affiliated organisations for the purpose of insurance, licensing or for publishing results of events, leagues and awards, and may use my image in RSHGA publications or for the furtherance of Highland games. This may include (but not be limited to) name, town, sports club, times/distances and age category. RSHGA will not share personal data with other organisations for the purposes of third-party marketing. I will notify RSHGA if I want to opt out of newsletters/mailings.
